Eid Milad ul Nabi 2019



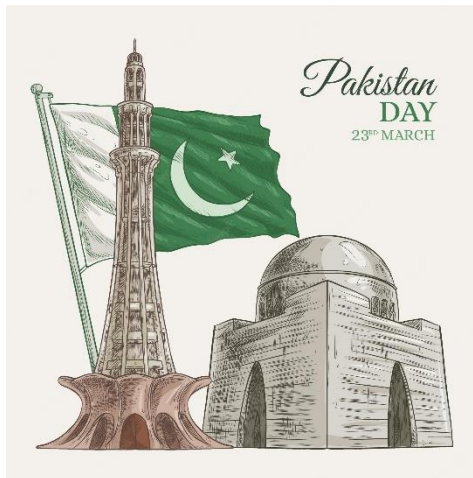
