THE LEGAL STATUS AND OPERATION:

Reformed Vision Presbyterian Society Karachi was registered with Community Development Department of City District Government Karachi on 21.06.2012 having registration No. DSW (3975)-K and it is situated at Plot No. GR-132, Bhattai Colony, Korangi Crossing, Karachi. The Society has two institutions under its management (Saman Educational Institute & Reformed Vision Presbyterian Church).

School children were taken for a Study Tour to Mohatta Palace Museum which is a source of pride for the citizens of Karachi as it aspires to become a museum of international standing and a beacon of hope and commitment to the city. Mohatta Palace Museum share our vision for a symbol of a cultural renaissance in Karachi.

Students learned about the history of the museum that in 1927, Shiv Rattan Mohatta constructed it in the affluent seaside of Clifton. Mohatta was a ship handler and trader. Ahmed Hussein Agha was one of the first Muslim architects of India and had come from Jaipur to take

up an assignment as chief surveyor for the Karachi Municipality. He designed a number of buildings in Karachi but Mohatta Palace was to prove the stroke of genius of his professional career. Working in a Mughal revival style with a combination of locally available yellow Gizri and pink stone from Jodhpur, he sought to recreate the Anglo Mughal palaces of the Rajput princes.

The students and the teachers on the study trip really enjoyed the tour and the students submitted their one page reflection of the visit of Mohatta palace Museum.
